

BEGINNING BUCKS POINT LACE

Introducing - temporary pins, catchpin stitch, point ground stitch, gimp, honeycomb rings, picots

24 pair wound continuously with any of the following:

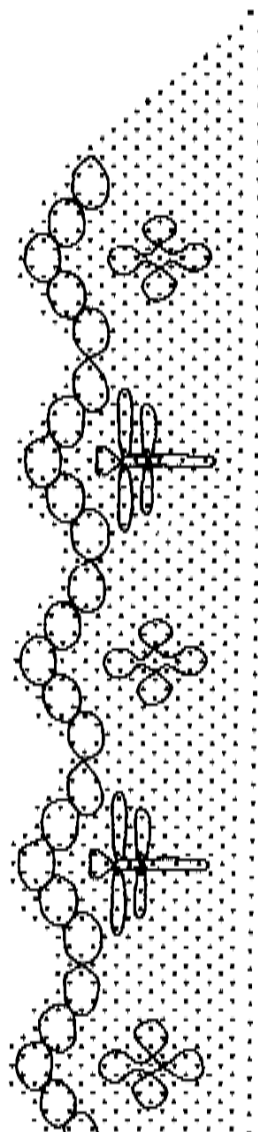
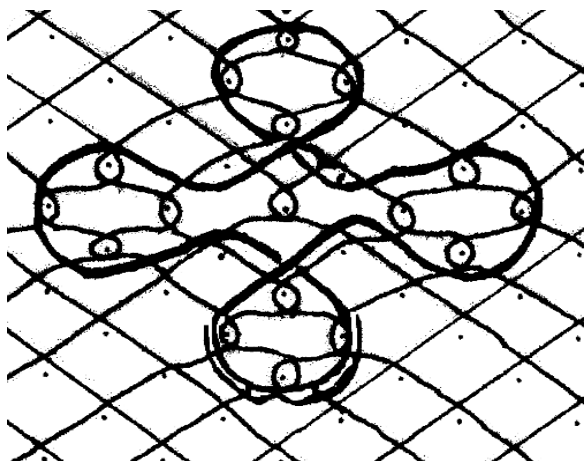
Egyptian cotton 50, 80/3 or 60

Maderia Tanne 50

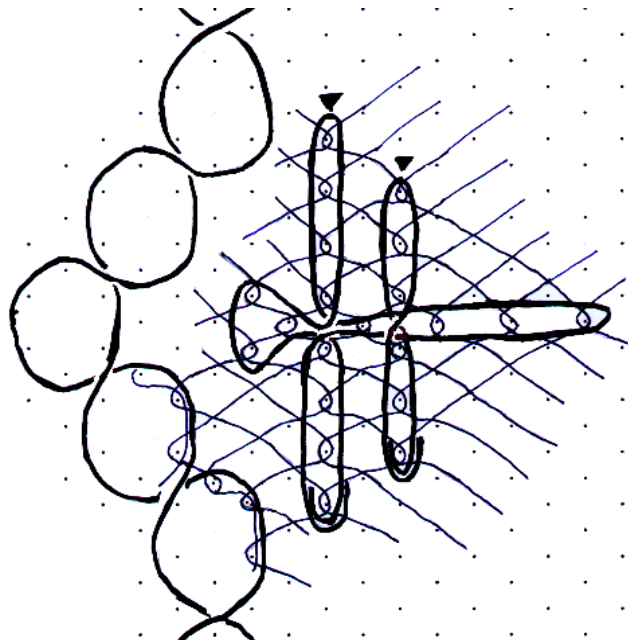
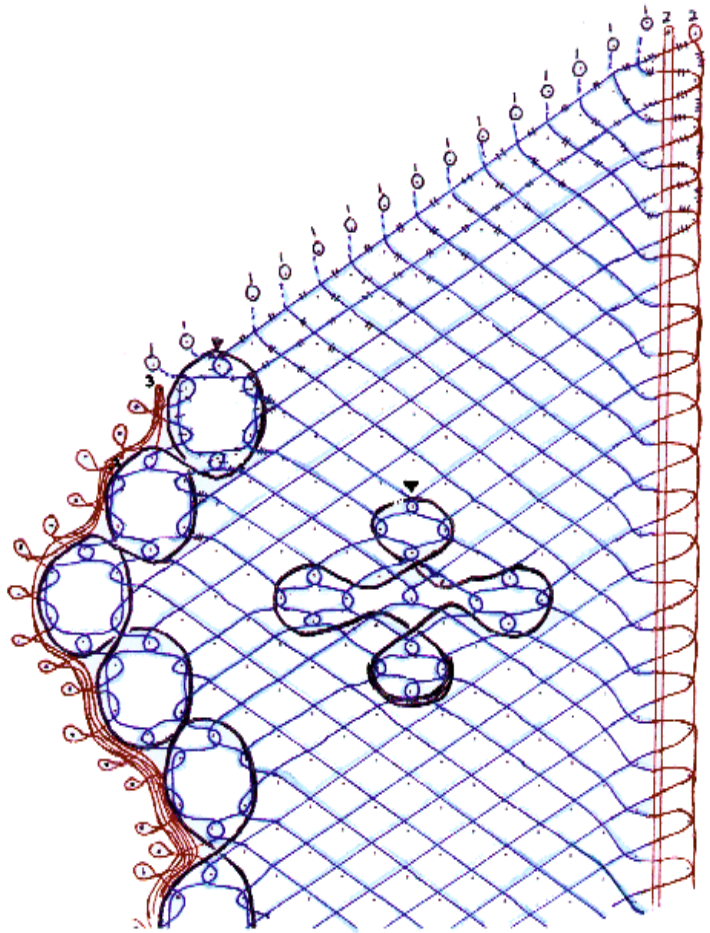
DMC Machine Broder 50

Sample worked in DMC Machine Broder 50 and DMC Pearl 8.

3 pair gimp wound continuously with DMC Pearl 8 or DMC Fil A Broder 16.



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Hint: The gimp threads on the wings are only held in place with one stitch so leave a long enough end before cutting off the bobbins to thread through a needle to secure them safely.
